World Environment Day

As part of the World Environment Day celebrations NCC cadets of our college planted many saplings in the campus. Ninety cadets of our college participated in the programme on 5th June 2019. They also cleaned the NCC office premises.



International Yoga Day - 21st June 2019:

The NCC Unit of our College participated in the International Yoga Day Celebration jointly arranged by four institutions under 11(K)Bn NCC Alappuzha, held at Kanichukulangara VHSS, Auditorium. The programme commenced at 7.30am and the class was instructed and demonstrated by Sri Sajeev and Sri. Rajesh of 'Art of living' Cherthala. It was followed by a talk by Smt. Sreeja from Excise Department, Cherthala, Govt. of Kerala, on the topic 'Anti-Drugs Campaign-Vimukthi'. One hundred and five cadets of our college participated in the programme. Total strength of the cadets attending the programme was 353. Breakfast was served for the entire cadets. Four ANOs and Two PI Staff from 11(K) Bn. led the entire programme. The programme ended at 10.30am.
